Subject: Revision of fee structure for Hospital & SHCO accreditation program from January 01, 2017.

Dear Sir/Madam,

Since last four years, there has been no change in the accreditation fee despite inflation and increase in costs for many services.

There is huge pressure on us to increase the fee by substantial percentage but again keeping in view of constraints on providers, NABH Board has decided to increase fee structure by **10% in the Annual Accreditation Fees only.**

The revised fee structure will be as follows:

Size of Hospitals	Accreditation Fee	
	Existing Annual Fee	Revised Annual Fee
Up to 100 beds	Rs. 1,50,000/-	Rs. 1,65,000/-
101-300 beds	Rs. 2,25,000/-	Rs. 2,50,000/-
301-500 beds	Rs. 3,25,000/-	Rs. 3,60,000/-
501 and above beds	Rs. 4,00,000/-	Rs. 4,40,000/-
SHCO	Rs. 1,00,000/-	Rs. 1,10,000/-

Service tax will be charged on all the above fees as applicable on the date of payment.

The revised fee structure will be applicable on all transactions from **January 01, 2017** onwards.
