Course details and fee: The 3 days course shall be conducted in onsite mode and the participant has to attend on all the three days. The training course involves interactive teaching & exercises. There would be an evaluation of the participants which includes daily monitoring of performance and a written examination on the last day. Only the successful participants would be considered for empanelment as NABH assessors. The fee for the training course is 15,000 + GST @ 18% (includes the cost of NABH standard and study material).

Eligibility Criteria for applying for Entry level Hospital Assessor's Course:

Essential Criteria

For Obstetrics and Gynaecology:

MBBS with post graduate qualification in Obstetrics and Gynaecology with 10 years of experience of which 5 years should be in a hospital. Higher qualification in clinical branch will be preferable.

Desirable Criteria (for all Categories)

- At least 5 years of experience in a NABH Accredited/Certified Hospital
- Attended POI on NABH Hospital Standards or Entry level standards
- Implementation of NABH Accreditation Standards in their respective Organization
- Higher Qualification and experience will be preferred
