

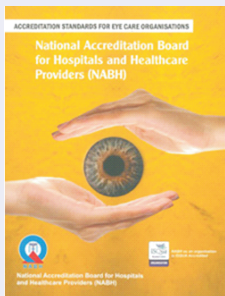
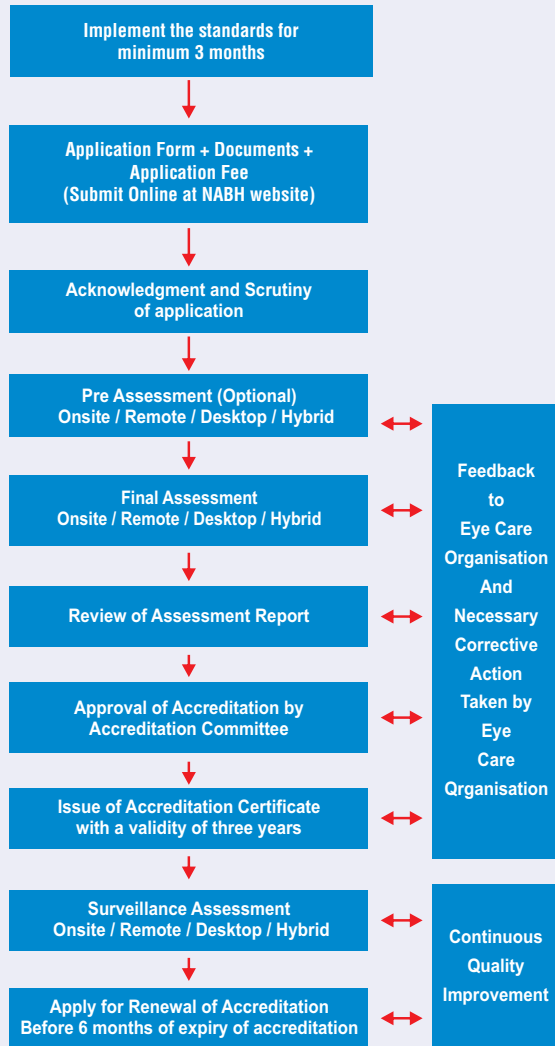

Introduction to NABH: National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers (NABH) is a constituent board of Quality Council of India (QCI) which is established with a vision to be the apex national healthcare accreditation and quality improvement body, functioning at par with global benchmarks. NABH as an organization is accredited by the International Society for Quality (ISQua) and is an institutional member of ISQua and ASQua.

Eye Care Accreditation : The Eye care organization standards were launched in the year 2017. Earlier the eye hospitals were considered under SHCO program for NABH accreditation but gradually it was observed that most of NABH standards related to SHCO were not applicable for Eye care organizations because of specified requirements of compliances, clinical processes, structures, manpower planning and the management of equipments. Adherence to accreditation standards in these settings improves quality of services leading to good clinical outcomes.

Benefits of Accreditation:

- ❖ Patients are the biggest beneficiary as implementation of accreditation standards ensures Patient safety, commitment to quality care resulting in good clinical outcomes.
- ❖ Improves patient satisfaction and increases community confidence as services are provided by credentialed medical staff.

- ❖ Accreditation provides an objective system of empanelment by insurance and other third parties

Who can apply?

Eye Care Organization that fulfills the following requirements:

- ❖ Currently in operation as Eye Care Organization.
- ❖ Eye Care Organization should have implemented NABH standards in the Eye Care Organization for a minimum of three months.
- ❖ The organization that commits to comply with NABH standards and applicable legal/statutory/ regulatory requirements.

How to apply for accreditation?
